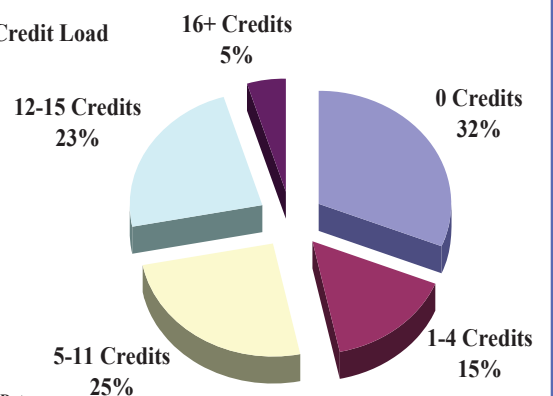

Enrollment by Credit Load

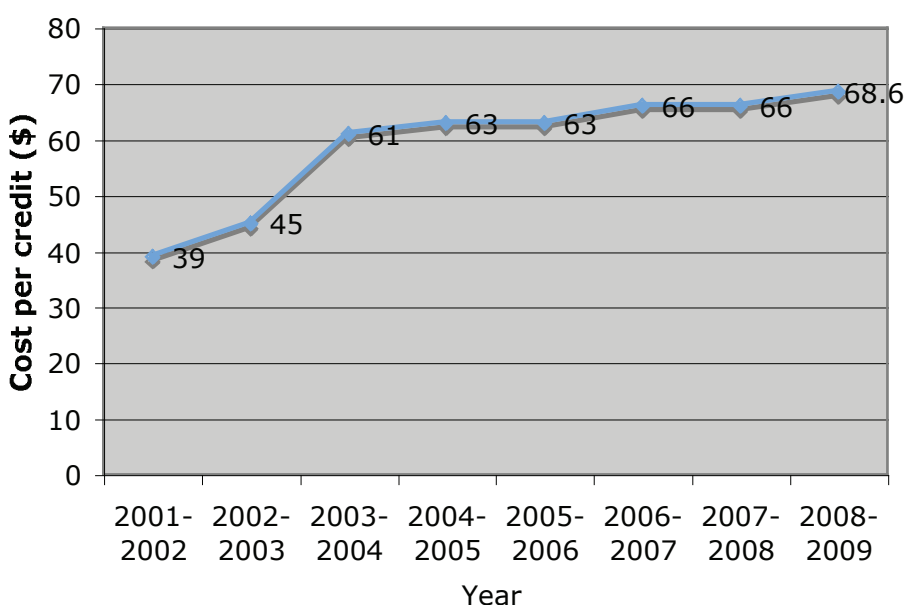
